Seeds	This will grow into a new plant.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> When you pick up a minibeast, remember to be respectful, they are living creatures. Spiders make webs to live in and can catch their own food. Insects have six legs, spiders have 8 legs Worms like living in damp soil and build tunnels. Worms come out after it has rained. Worms don't have eyes; they feel vibrations instead. They move by using their bristles and muscles. You must wash your hands after handling minibeasts because they may have germs. We can grow our own food, flowers and plants. Seeds need water, sunlight and nutrients from the soil to grow.

Wormery	A home for worms.	
Nutrients	Plants take these from the soil, they need these to grow	
Damp	Slightly wet.	
Vibrations	Moving quickly back and forth.	
Magnifying glass	We use a magnifying glass or bug collector to observe mini beasts more closely, it makes them look bigger.	
Bristles	Tiny hairs on a minibeast's body	
Planting	Putting plants into the ground or a plant pot
