

Twitch is a livestreaming service which tends to focus on gaming. Users can publicly broadcast their gameplay and commentary online for other users to watch II is a community-driven platform where viewers can support their favourite streamers' channels through PayPal donations, "Bits" and more Each streamer or group creater their own community for fans to interact with each other. Twitch has more than 19 million daily active asers and includes non-gaming tapics such as music cocking and ort. Anyone can create a channel to investream or watch videos

#### UNCENSORED STREAMS

WHAT ARE THE RISKS?

Uncensored content obviously corries a greater risk al inappropriate inageopa and behaviour (atneamers con, however, list their broadcost as unsuitable for children). Twitch has strict rules for streamers to follow, but requires viewers its report carry streams which breach these guidelines. #### HIDDEN COSTS

Twitch is free to use because it's supported by advertisers. Removing the ads requires a subscription to Twitch Turbs – or the Twitch Prime package (here for ampone with an Amazon Prime account), which blocks the ads and others additional goodles such as becaus games. #### PRIVATE CHAT ROOMS

29 Twitch encourages streament to create their own communities, which extend beyond is plottom. Many create a public Discord group, for example, for viewers to join and communicate with each other. Discord is a completely separate entity to Ewisch and others a higher risk of predators, grooming and cyberbullying if your child gets involved in the voice or video chot with throngers.
