### Who are Rainbow Leaders?

### What are the Rainbow Leader Teams?

There are 10 Teams in total (this is in addition to our School Council who meet separately). All the information you need about the teams is in this booklet.



### *When will the Rainbow Leader Teams Meet?*

Rainbow Leader Teams will meet one afternoon every half term - these will be called our 'Aspiration Afternoons'. Teams will be made up of children from across Y1- Y6.

### *How do I join a Rainbow Leaders Team?*

Every year on Democracy Day (usually the 2<sup>nd</sup> week in September), children will be able to select 3 teams they are interested in joining. Places will then be allocated accordingly.



Can I be on the School Council and in a Rainbow Leader Team?

Yes! The School Council will meet separately.

Children have the option of nominating themselves to be a school councillor each Democracy Day too. Y6 can also nominate themselves to be Head Boy/Head Girl.

Come and join the celebration of what makes us special!

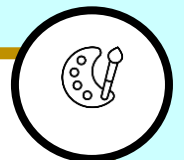


## Creation Champions

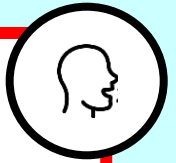


### Attendance Avengers
