Support to access wider curriculum

Throughout their time at Parish, children will receive the curriculum offer through our Rainbow Curriculum. Due to their special educational needs, some children will require additional support to access this wider curriculum including differentiated tasks, additional prompts and support or specialised equipment. Further to this, some children may require a more bespoke, modified curriculum which has been specifically developed to meet their individual needs. These children receive a curriculum that is tailored to their individual needs, led by assessments and recommendations from external agencies.

Universal life skills

Life skills are essential for pupils for them to become independent and successful. Developing life skills is embedded into our curriculum for all pupils at Parish, but especially those with additional needs. Carefully planned activities, experiences and routines are incorporated into the daily routines of children who need support in developing their interpersonal skills and emotional regulation. In providing opportunities for children to develop their life skills we aim to prepare them for life beyond Parish.

Nurturing and Inclusivity
