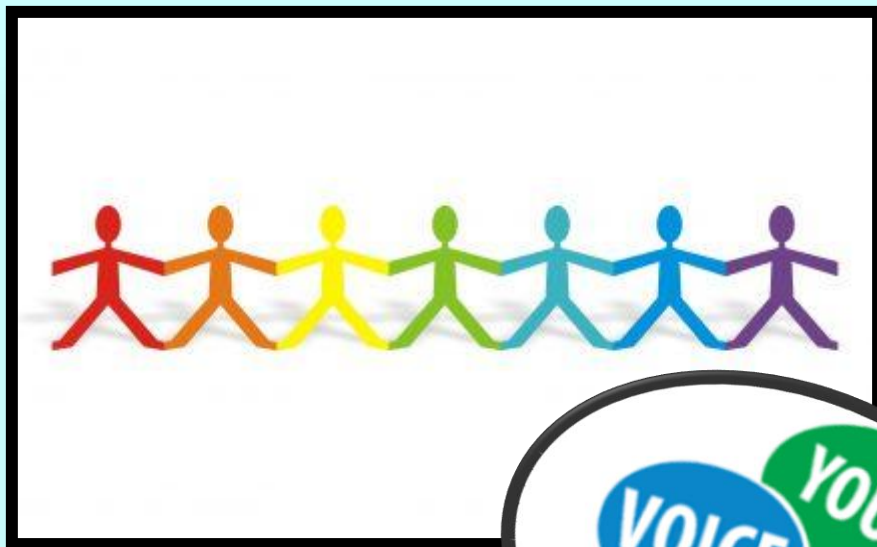

Who are Rainbow Leaders?

Our Rainbow Leaders approach reflects our commitment to our 7 Rainbow Promises - especially 'Inspiring Aspirations'. It allows every child from Y1-Y6 to be a member of a Pupil Leadership Team and to make a difference to their school community each and every day!



What are the Rainbow Leader Teams?

There are 9 Teams in total (this is in addition to our School Council who meet separately). All the information you need about the teams is in this booklet.



When will the Rainbow Leader Teams Meet?

Rainbow Leader Teams will meet one afternoon every half term as part of our 'Lead Like Us' days. Teams will be made up of children from across Y1-Y6.

The School Council again will meet separately.



How do I join a Rainbow Leaders Team?

Every year on Democracy Day (usually the 2nd week in September), children will be able to select 3 teams they are interested in joining. Places will then be allocated accordingly.



Can I be on the School Council and in a Rainbow Leader Team?

Yes! The School Council will meet separately.

Children have the option of nominating themselves to be a school councillor each Democracy Day too. Y6 can also nominate themselves to be a Head Pupil.

The Happiness Heroes will work together to make sure all our voices are heard and promote diversity, equality and inclusion across our school.

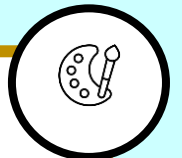
We will help Parish pupils to be resilient and prepared for life in modern Britain also considering 'My Happy Minds' considering the importance of positive wellbeing and health.
